

Borough of Portland Council Meeting Minutes December 27, 2023

Call to Order - Vice-President Patrick McHugh called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Approval of the Meeting Agenda and any Amendments:

The Council approved by consensus the Meeting Agenda as presented, without any amendments.

Resolution 2023-09: Resolution Appointing Kirk, Summa & Co, LLP, as the Borough of Portland's Independent Auditor for Purposes of Auditing the Borough's Accounts for the 2023 Fiscal Year.

Solicitor Gaul presented proposed Resolution 2023-09, which appoints the certified public accounting firm of Kirk, Summa & Co, LLP, (the "Independent Auditor"), as the Borough's independent auditor for purposes of the 2023 fiscal year audit. The Resolution states that the compensation of the Independent Auditor shall be \$7,000 and paid from Borough funds. The Resolution approves the Independent Auditor's engagement letter of October 30, 2023, and authorizes the Borough Council President or Vice President to execute and deliver the letter. Solicitor Gaul advised that because the Resolution already contains an authorization for execution of the engagement letter, Agenda item 6b was redundant and did not need to be separately addressed.

A motion was made by Councilmember Karen Pfeiffer to adopt Resolution 2023-09, seconded by Councilmember Lisa Prator. Vote 4-0-0; Motion Carried
