

Sanitary Sewer Customers Residential & Commercial

Please remember that ONLY human waste and flushable water are the ONLY things that should be going down the drain. NO antifreeze, NO paint thinners, NO heavy duty cleaners, NO medical waste, NO needles of any sort should be put in the drain.

Cleaners and chemicals cause a disruption to the bacteria at the treatment plant and can lead to monetary fines and substantial costs to all sewer customers.

Just because something says it is biodegradable or compost "green", does not mean it can go down the drain.

Medical waste and needles also pose a problem to the treatment process as those items have to be removed by person, thus costing additional expenses as well as the potential for exposure to contaminants.

Please dispose of ALL items properly and in accordance with the Sanitary Sewer Ordinance. Violators will be prosecuted.
